differential for another drink. Only one chit per drink is accepted. Time to enjoy!

Question: Hey Mike, do we still need to wear masks indoors?

Answer: Alameda County still requires masks to be worn indoors. If you are seated, enjoying a libation or eating, you do not need to wear a mask. If you get up to walk around, wear a mask.
