Several officers and wives attended the Elk's Convention in Riverside early November. We learned and will be implementing many of the ideas and the direction that CHEA is headed for next year.




We are looking for a replacement for our Bingo Chairman. If you are interested in assuming this chairmanship, please contact myself or one of the trustees.


Keep an eye out on our Fremontelks.org website, and bulletin for any updates.




